Glass, wall hung

Beth Colledge focuses on the medium of glass, with her work taking inspiration from mediaeval times. This collection draws on Arthurian legend, and highlights escapism through myth and legend. The functional drinking vessels are a modern interpretation of drinking horns, with their organic shapes being symbolic of ancient mythical creatures. Beth's crafted forms sculpt to the user's hand, and her use of colours are reminiscent of the stained glass windows used to depict stories to the masses.
