
Architecture

In these visualisations, Daniel Shaw reimagines a Leicester high street, Queen's Road, as a pedestrianised hub for local businesses, creatives and families to come together as a patchwork of community.



Taking inspiration from Leicester's rich history in the textile industry, the title 'Patchwork of Queens' makes reference to the bringing together of different pieces to create a more resilient whole.

Through the pedestrianisation of Queen's Road, the high street is strengthened by the creation of community spaces, and contributes to cleaner air and safer places for children.
