

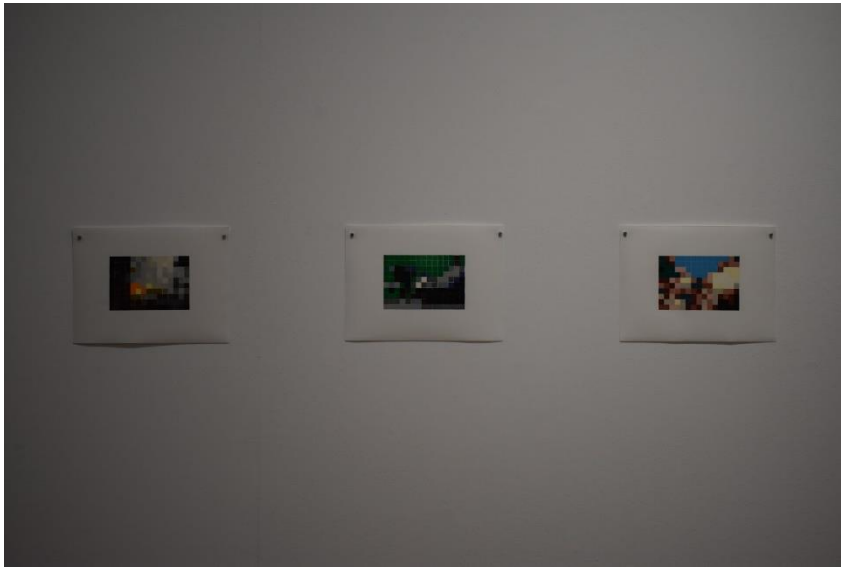
The Magic of the Real
