
Sound 2023


LCB Depot's exhibition & events programme highlight works from different creative practices every month.

Artist Bio

I was born in Cordoba, Argentina, on June 20 1980. After finishing high school at the Aeronautical Technical School of Fuerza Aerea, Argentina (1999), I began my studies at the Universidad Technologica Nacional.

In 2001, after abandoning the Electronic Engineering Major, I began studying to be a Physical Education Professor (IPEF). Upon graduating, I travelled for two years, visiting countries in South America, Europe, the Middle East, and the north of Africa. In 2009, living in Madrid and continuing with sports, I became licensed in "Physical Activity and Sports".

However, in 2010 I began a masters program in Social Anthropology at the Universidad Nacional de Cordoba. Whilst attending classes, I met Graciela De Oliveira, with whom I shared courses, translation projects, and my first collaboration in relational art (2011).

Midway through 2012, I returned to Europe and began the photographic work "Memorias de verde". Upon my return to Argentina, I completed an artist residency at the Casa/Estudio Batz, sharing production space with Pablo Boneu and Luis Gonzalez Palma, culminating in the completion of my masters thesis.

Moving back to my city of birth, Cordoba, in 2013, I started working at the National Military Aircraft factory. A year later, I was in a transit accident; this event changed my life and radically affected my creative processes.
