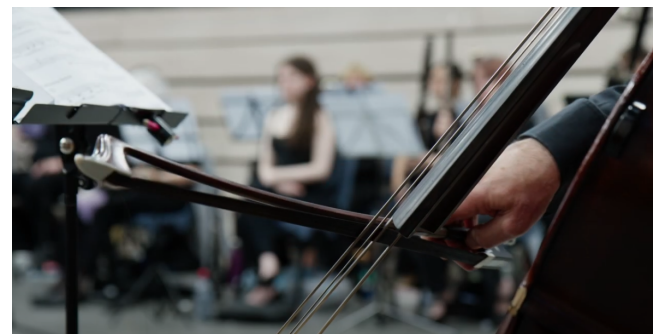
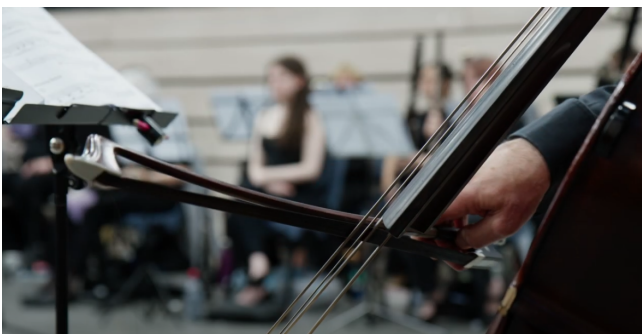


Sound 2023

Duskman, specially composed for the title theme piece of a Leicester produced movie, is a recording by the Leicester Symphony Orchestra, written by local composer, Kirby Spencer and conducted by John Andrews. Recorded on 31st July 2023 by Midlands Sessions Recording, and GMFinney Productions at Judgemeanow Community College, this piece will feature in the film set to be released in 2024.

It is the first time in the LSO's 102 year history that an entire film score has been recorded, and brings together an exciting new venture of creative collaboration both in film and in music.

Kirby, with years of experience with this orchestra, responded well to the collective strengths of the local musicians and consequently created an enjoyable score to both participate and watch.

This collection of sounds is an invitation for new audiences to enjoy the excitement of live orchestral concerts, and for new film-makers to commission live music to accompany their films in the future.
