And when the group was at the peak of popularity, he left it because he wanted to make his own music and play in the orchestra, as well as completing his musical education at the Academy of Music.

In 2019, Pafnutiy gave a speech at TED x Talk, 'where to start learning music' He currently plays the French horn in an orchestra and writes music for performances. He says he will record the next album when the time comes.
