


Design 2023

hsd collaborated with the **European Molecular Biology Laboratory (EMBL)** in Heidelberg, creating an introduction to the cutting-edge research undertaken at the new Imaging Centre. The exhibit provides engaging and accessible content for both non-specialist educational group visitors and those with a specialist interest visiting this leading scientific institution. Following an extensive redevelopment project, the Smithsonian's **National Air and Space Museum** recently reopened the west wing of its building in the heart of Washington, D.C. Over a 7-year engagement, hsd mapped out a revitalised visitor journey through the careful design of each gallery. NASM's stunning collections are freshly displayed, hundreds of new artefacts are featured, and exhibits are accompanied by a dynamic mix of immersive media.

hsd was honoured to be part of the exhibition design team for Phase II galleries at the soon-to-open **Grand Egyptian Museum**, located near the Great Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx of Egypt. It will become the world's largest museum devoted to a single civilization, reinforcing Egypt's cultural identity and pride in its rich heritage. Within the permanent exhibition, hsd has designed the Main Galleries which cover some 17 000 sqm of space and feature an artefact-led journey. Engaging narratives are revealed, and history is unpacked through the stories of people and events encapsulated within the artefacts.
