Together is a set of thrown and assembled vessels reflecting on community and how we are all unique but can come together to create a new, better whole. Inspired by the natural world, the pebblelike stacks are finished with ash and eggshell glazes, which links back to the earth inspiration.

## **Artist Bio**

I am a ceramicist specialising in thrown vessels and aim to create objects that feel inviting and homey. I take inspiration from the natural world and the community around me, as it has played an important role in my life, shaping me into who I am. I use this in my work showing how we are all unique and come together to create a new beautiful whole. Working with clay, I work with its strengths and qualities, leaning into the earthy qualities of it, creating

organic forms and surface finishes. I am passionate about sustainable practice and aim to action it in my work, including using waste material in my glazes, that would otherwise be thrown away. I've created my own glazes out of wood ash and eggshells, which links back to and enhances the earthy theme of my work. With my work my goal is to create tactile pieces, that are warm and convey a feeling of togetherness.
