
Craft 2024: Collected

Metal brooches on a plinth

Elinor has created a set of three brooches which have been hand fabricated in metal. There are inserts which are reversible, each having a different design on each insert face. The screw threaded system in the centre allows the inserts to come out and be put back in. Elinor has taken inspiration from the writer and author J.R.R Tolkien to create the brooches.
