Jamie Seymour

A featureless yellow swan is centred as a point of desire and tension in this image, as a disembodied floating smile gazes down on him. Below the red painterly water, a sinister creature is partly obscured by the swan's reflection, perhaps about to strike or perhaps just looking to, like the voyeur above.

Artist Bio

Jamie Seymour is a Leicestershire-based artist who graduated from The Ruskin School of Art, Oxford University, in 2020. Their work straddles the point between the poetic and the pathetic through a multidisciplinary practice spanning performance, sculpture, painting and drawing. The anxiety of transformation lies at the core of their creations, often alluding to history, folklore and an ever-expanding personal symbology. The queer body is centred as a vulnerable, shifting state in their work — existing in a world of slippery fallacy, detritus and uncertainty.
