I'm studying design crafts at De Montfort University. All my work has the theme of mythology, animals and mythical creatures. This project is themed

What is unique about the work is the use of scanning in plasticine models and then and then scan them in and then 3D print them larger and then casted once a plaster mold is made. Then artists works over the cast they get out the mold to make their work from this project.
