Conversations with Barnacles, Fungi and Folklore, Bloom and Blossom

Lucy Crisp Ceramics

Porcelain wall panels, free standing sculptures made with wood and porcelain

Lucy's work explores the textures and colours created by the natural world. Working in porcelain clay allows her to push the boundaries of the material and celebrate the beauty of handmade.

The porcelain is combined with volcanic glaze in the 'Conversations with Barnacles' wall panels to create a sea foam textural effect whilst velvet

underglaze creates the

subtle colour on the hydrangea inspired wall panels in the 'Bloom and Blossom' series. The wooden sculptures are made using reclaimed fence posts and other foraged wood with tiny porcelain fungi creating miniature magical worlds.



Bell jars, mini mushrooms, handmade cards and jewellery are Lucy's most recent ranges.

the open air with her young family. She graduated from DMU Design Crafts in 2009 then trained to teach and has recently started making again.
