Marie's semi-abstract mixed media paintings invite the viewer to explore the marks of history that a landscape bears, much of it hidden. This coastal piece was inspired by the incoming sea mist on the north-east coast of Northumbria, giving the scene an air of mystery and illusion...where does the sea end and the land begin?

Artist Bio

Originally from Derbyshire I have long been inspired by the wild areas and moorlands of the Peak District, but also the North-east coast and Yorkshire moors. 50 years ago my family moved to Wiltshire and I fell in love with that mysterious landscape of ancient monuments and standing stones. My mixed media paintings explore the marks left on the land and search for the hidden meaning our ancestors found there. I am more concerned with capturing a feeling, 'spirit of place' than recognisable places. Most recently I have had my work shown in the White Chalk gallery, Devizes and locally at Wistow; I am a member of the LSA and have exhibited at ArtHouse Leicester. I am a member of KLA studios.
