'Elevated Formation' is a collection of metal bowls assembled in an architectural way, to explore the forms of the shapes together. They are inspired by how geometric shapes can change with the process of raising. Each bowl started from different shaped flat sheets of metal. The chased textures on some of the bowls were influenced by the texture of shells.

I am a second year Design Craft student specialising in metal. In my work I like to use metal to explore sculpture and shape which is driven by processes. I like how working in metal means I can control every step by hand. My



favourite technique is raising because I like how I can change the way metal is shaped gradually. It is time consuming but rewarding as I really like the outcome. I find it interesting how flat shapes can look so different once raised. I like seeing how different metal finishes can affect a piece, such as adding texture and colour.
