These two pieces have been made in response to natural objects found on a beach near where Ruth grew up. She has focused on particular shapes and textures that she has found interesting. Ruth has used embroidery on layers of paint on unprimed calico.

## Artist Bio

Ruth is a multi-media visual artist who is interested in exploring and playfully experimenting with different media. She tends to move between media over time, but is currently focused on watercolours, paper, threads and fabric. Her practice can be very process led, pushing materials to see what they will do when combined or what affects how paint dries or how it sits on fabrics and paper. Working without a fixed idea of outcome, but enjoying creating, responding to the visual images that have been created through this process and reflecting on how they could be drawn or painted or sewn into.

Ruth joined Knighton Lane Artists in 2024. Since then she has participated in Open Studios events, been part of the group exhibit at The Leicester Coffee House and currently has work up at The Toll Bar Cafe in Preston. Ruth has also been delivering children's visual arts workshops in schools and libraries in Leicestershire and Luton.
