I am a designer and Jeweller based in Nottingham. With my love for drawing and design, I began my career illustrating my interest for history, fashion and storytelling though a variety of mediums. Working predominantly with precious metals, my practice is rooted in the traditional craft of jewellery making with sculpting, chasing and the last wax cast process.
