Artist Bio

Sim Seema Mistry is a fine artist known for her vibrant use of colour intricate patterns and mixed media that blend traditional techniques with modern



themes. Her work often explores cultural identity, spirituality, and personal narratives, drawing on her heritage and experiences. Seema's art uniquely combines elements of South Asian art with abstract expressionism, creating pieces that feel both familiar and avant-garde.
