Unheard Voices

Unheard Voices of the Travelling Community is part of an ongoing Oral Histories project. Funded by the National Lottery Heritage Fund, this work was created in conjunction with Leicestershire GATE (A grass roots community project aimed at reducing the knowledge gap between the Traveller/Gypsy and the wider society). In documenting those who are not normally heard we often hear a voice that is marginalised and/or misrepresented. These photos and the accompanying audio interviews give a voice and visual representation to individuals from these excluded groups, and advocate for inclusion as envisaged in the SDG Goal 10: Reduced Inequality.



Artist Bio

Tom Wren - An award-winning professional photographer who specialises in photographing everything! His work focuses on capturing a moment in time, whether it's portraiture, lifestyle photography, or just the perfect light. Clients include a variety of local and international businesses, magazines and online marketing and publications.

Rhys Davies - A creative director who has developed numerous installations, artwork and photography projects including Fireflies - an audio-visual interactive installation based upon flocking behaviour and synchronisation, and Shift - 420 bespoke holographic prints and a stereo projection created using a technique which analyzed sonic material gathered from different areas of Leicester. He is also a film director and writer, with theatrical release and worldwide distribution of his films, and was assistant director on two Oscar long-listed short films.
