juxtaposition of Nature and Architecture, Ceramics and Textiles.

Artist Bio

Hannah Heys is a multidisciplinary Artist & Designer, living in Cheddington, Buckinghamshire.



Creating decorative contemporary ceramics, inspired by the juxtaposition of Nature and Architecture, Ceramics and Textiles. Each vase is handcrafted using either stoneware or porcelain clay, these hand thrown forms act as a blank canvas ready for freehand delicate decoration using sgraffito and slip trailed techniques, in a variety of striking colours.

Each vase highlights the contrast between the delicacy of the almost lace like decoration against the strength and rigidity of the high fired ceramics. The detailed abstract freehand decorations combine Hannah's background and experience in Textiles, Surface Design, Pattern and Embroidery with her love for bold forms, shapes and intricate decorative techniques of ceramics.

All works are hand made by Hannah in her Buckinghamshire studio, each piece is an individual one-off creation.
