Futile Acts

Issie Martin

'Futile Acts: The Chalk Bucket' is a document of a performance using chalk tools to save the land and prevent flooding. Issie explores her relationship to bodies of water and the uncertainty of eroding coastlines in a time of ecological crisis - specifically her home on the East Kent coast. Issie's satirical acts criticise a lack of action in the face of a changing climate and investigate the conflict of individual helplessness and the need for collective action. The

fragile materials were, obviously, ineffective and documenting these performances demonstrates the ephemerality of both the material and our ecological stability.
