
## Conflicted

'Memory Piece' is an audiovisual documentary composed of digital video, 35mm photography & sound recordings collated across the last 2 years. Devised manually using dissolve & transparency techniques. Far from an attempt to clearly render the past, images & sounds merge & blend together, losing cohesion, the resulting textures & tones are often discordant. A largely accurate document nevertheless.

## **Artist Bio**

"I'm a filmmaker, documentarian & audio-visual artist from the Midlands, I turned 24 in December & I currently live in North London where I work in post-production.

Graduate of BA Film Production with 1st Class Hons from the University of Salford. I work across documentary, music video & art film. My short documentary 'Overground' (2023) screened in 5 UK film festivals. Last year I was on the Youth Jury at Sheffield Doc Fest & produced a piece on the city of Leicester for the Media Archive for Central England as part of the BFI Save Our Screen Heritage initiative.

A disciplinary interest in documentary film developed throughout my undergraduate studies, in part sparked by access to the North West Film Archive for a short piece on Salford's changing & unchanging structures, culminating in a music documentary film which expanded upon this North West historiography.
