Whitecaps is a porcelain wall piece decorated with fluid clay forms inspired by the breaking of waves and the whitecaps that form. She has been fascinated with exploring how movement creates natural patterns and has extracted these to develop delicate decorations that mimic the ocean while creating a visually satisfying work of art.

Artist Bio

Molly Beach is a ceramicist based in the West Midlands, currently studying BA Design Craft at De Montfort University specialising in hand-built ceramics. Her

work explores movement through abstract forms and pattern. She often makes to a larger scale, creating visually striking pieces through her use of porcelain and coloured bodies of clay, developing themes using dynamic shapes and lines. Molly's current work is an extension of her interest in design for interior, with the collection of work debuting at LCB being ceramic wall installations taking inspiration from the curl of waves.
